The focus is on the writing of academic texts and professional reports that require citation and the synthesis of information from diverse sources. Skills from this course are transferable to writing in German. This course is recommended as preparation for students who plan to write theses as well as those who will be required to write complex professional reports (such as engineering reports). Please note that this course does not cover job-related skills such as writing basic business emails and CVs.</p>
